KEN'S PEN

Teaching: Blessings and Responsibilities

Every blessing that we receive has an equal sense of responsibility: "Blessed is that servant whom his master, when he comes, will find so doing" (Mat. 24:45; cf. Jas. 1:25). In the case of teaching, there are several areas in which these blessings and responsibilities manifest themselves. The difficulty, however, is in realizing that we should accept these responsibilities with the same fervor as the blessings that preceded them. Regardless of one's joy and enthusiasm, the underlying benefits for filling the teaching position go much further than the mere satisfaction of filling a vacated position; it becomes the seat by which God's Word is transferred from one life to another.

Teachers occupy a God-ordained role in the church as co-workers with God (Mat. 28:19f; Acts 13:1). They are leaders and stewards of the Word among the fellowship (2 Cor. 4:7). The blessings and responsibilities related to these attributes are quite extensive and endlessly rewarding. There is the satisfaction of having influenced future generations for good; the honor of co-laboring with God; the sense of accomplishment at having done a job well; and the opportunity for personal development through preparatory study.

Responsibilities are a welcome challenge to the conscientious worker. It is not simply the restating of facts that motivates the student to new heights, but rather a conveyance of experiences and observations that help to bring about reformation and change. This goal of bettering a life through a practical application of the Word of Truth is the teacher's highest calling.

Teachers that accept the difficult task of imparting these truths to us are definitely worthy of our esteem, for they are risking stricter judgment in order to share their biblical discoveries with us (Jas. 3:1). Take the time to give thanks for them and to recognize the awesome responsibility that they have taken upon themselves for our benefit (1 Ths. 5:12f).

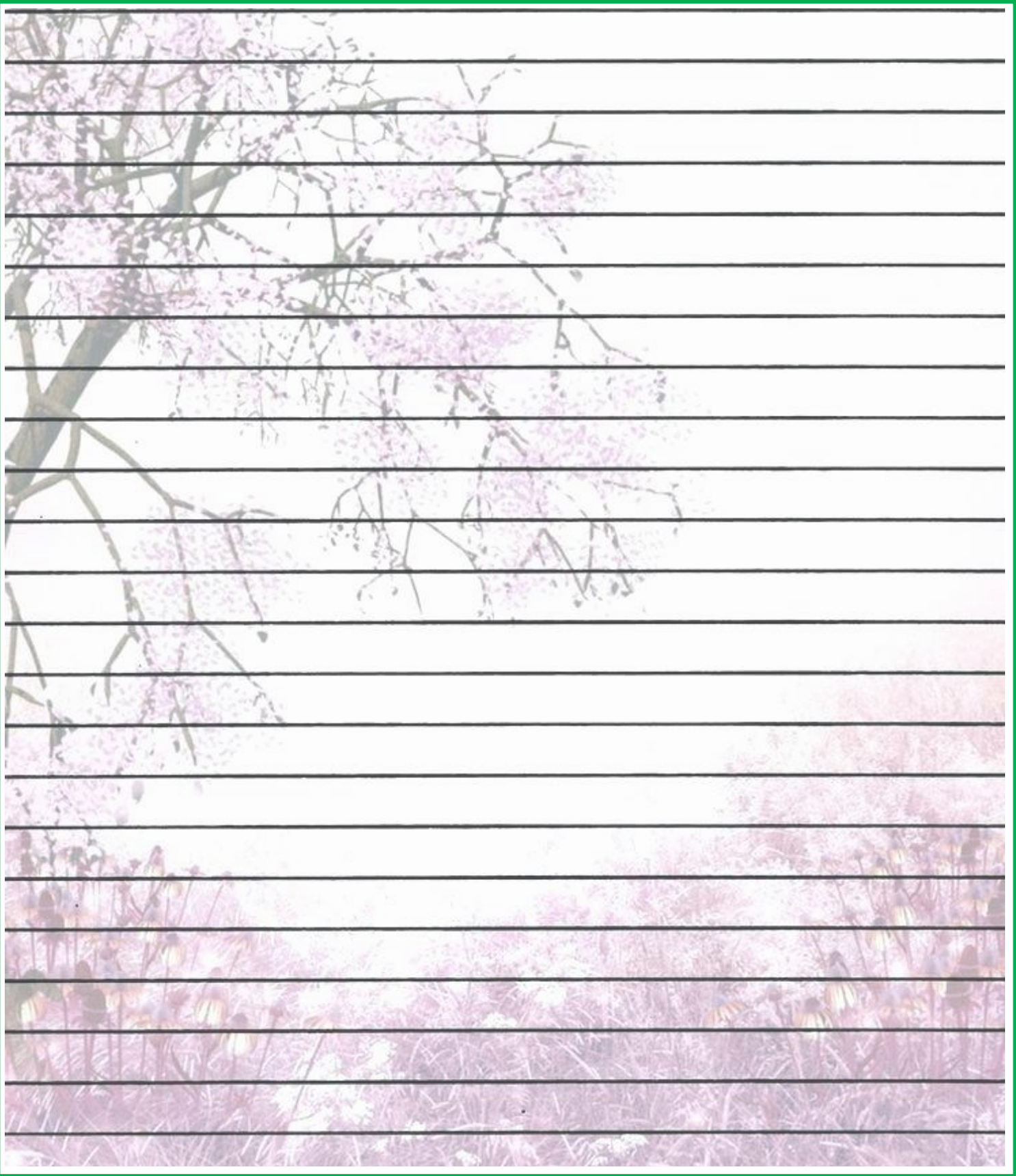
