## KEN'S PEN

### An Open Door Policy

<sup>7</sup>“And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write, “These things says He who is holy, He who is true, “He who has the key of David, He who opens and no one shuts, and shuts and no one opens”: <sup>8</sup>“I know your works. See, I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it; for you have a little strength, have kept My word, and have not denied My name” (Rev. 3:7-8).

The church in Philadelphia, although possessing “a little strength,” was made aware of what Christ was doing for them: “I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it” (v. 8). In spite of their diminutive vigor, the Lord's favor was achieved as a result of their steadfastness in the word, and a daily commitment to Christlikeness. Though their strength was not proportionate to the wide door of opportunity opened to them, yet it had kept them faithful.

The message to the church in Philadelphia is one that we need to hear at Summerdale. With a growing enthusiasm for the work that is now in progress, it should be our determination that our focus will not become blurred, nor our growing strength diminished.

When Christ is acknowledged as the Author of all the liberty and opportunity that the church enjoys, we can expect to achieve success in spite of the temporary obstacles that may arise.

When Christ takes notice of how long He has preserved our spiritual liberties and privileges, He will expect to see some measurable degree of progress, as we are accountable for the resources that He has placed at our disposal.

When wicked men envy us because of the doors of blessings that God has opened upon us, and would be glad to shut them against us, Christ will faithfully hold open the doors so long as we do not lay down under their attacks.

If we do not provoke Christ to shut these doors against us, there is simply nothing that men can do to hinder our progress. Why? Because the Lord is with us!

**LADS TO LEADERS BEGINS NOW!**

Several people have asked me: "When does Lads to Leaders begin?" It officially begins now! We've had a couple meetings in the last month to introduce (or re-introduce) the program to the church family. We are super excited to announce some of our plans for moving forward.

**1) Focusing on year round events.** We are already accumulating data on the participation of our kids in Bible Reading, Song Leading (guys only), Songs of Praise (girls only), Speech, and Good Samaritan. This will serve as one of main concentrations. We will also work on pre-convention events, but I will announce more about that in December.

**2) Junior Leader program will begin on Sunday night, November 3.** All children from pre-K to 5<sup>th</sup> grade will be encouraged to attend a NEW Sunday night program! Every Sunday night we will have youth led singing, speeches, service projects and activities while the adults are in the evening worship service. This serves two purposes: Get the younger children involved in the program and utilize our teenagers in training the younger children. Occasionally we may have puppets and videos, but this will serve primarily as a fun-filled training class in the old skit room in the fellowship hall.

**3) Studying the gospel of Luke for Bible Bowl competition.** This year we are starting a little late, but still have plenty of time to get ready for the Orlando convention (April 9-12, 2020). We are planning on teaching this book on Sunday mornings to the teenagers. I will serve as the primary teacher of this material for two quarters (26 weeks). This is an exciting gospel account and we are eager to help our young people to learn it!

You might still be thinking: "What can I do?" You can get involved! Pray for the L2L program. Bring your children to Bible classes and Junior Leader. Encourage your teens to stay active.
